



The Mapletree-TENG Academy Scholarship 2018 Guidelines

1. Aim

2. Scope of Scholarship

Four candidates will be selected for a two-year scholarship for value at S\$5,000 per year, that will cover the following: -

- i. Music instrumental lessons with an instructor who is approved by The TENG Academy
- ii. Registration fees and Exam scores for the Chinese Music Instrumental Grading Examinations, conducted by The TENG Academy and Confucius Institute-NTU
- iii. ABRSM music theory lessons, teaching materials, and examination fees
- iv. The opportunity to pay-it-forward and be involved in The TENG Ensemble's community initiative, '*TENG Gives Back*'

3. Selection Criteria

Applicants will be assessed based on their **musical talent and financial capability**.

Eligibility:

- i. Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident (PR)
- ii. Between the ages 7 to 21 as of 31 December 2018
- iii. Plays a Chinese instrument or an instrument found in Chinese Orchestras (e.g. Cello, Double Bass and Western Percussion)
- iv. Per Capita Income (PCI) of S\$1500.00 or lower. Please submit the following supporting documents in your application,
 - o Proof of income of all working members in the family

Note: The TENG Academy reserves the right to request for more information and additional supporting documents if necessary

4. Additional Provisions

Subject to approval and availability, these items may be provided under the Scholarship,

- i. Provision or purchase of music instrument
- ii. The opportunity to attend an overseas music exchange programme

5. Requirements

Interested applicants should provide the following,

- i. A completed copy of the Mapletree-TENG Academy Scholarship 2018 Application Form with all the supporting documents
- ii. Proof of Income of all working members in the family
- iii. A photocopy of your NRIC (front and back) for Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents
- iv. Photocopies of scholarships / grants / financial aid awarded (if any)
- v. Photocopies of music grading certificates / awards (if any)
- vi. At least 1 Letter of Recommendation from either a Teacher or an Instructor
- vii. A video recording not exceeding 5 minutes OR a writeup not exceeding 500 words discussing the following:
 - o Your achievements and experiences in music
 - o Your musical goals and aspirations
 - o How you intend to contribute to Chinese music in Singapore
 - o Your thoughts on the challenges that Chinese music faces in Singapore

8. Interview and Audition Process

You will be assessed by a panel of three judges or more, comprising of a representative from The TENG Academy, Mapletree, an external expert in the field of music, and such other persons approved by The TENG Academy and Mapletree.

What you will need to prepare:

- i. A 3-minute long performance piece. You will be asked to present this piece to the panel after the interview
- ii. Your music score
- iii. Your own musical instrument. Do note that The TENG Academy will only be providing the following instruments,
 - a) *Guzheng*
 - b) *Yangqin*
 - c) Double Bass
 - d) *Zhongyin Sheng* – 中音笙
 - e) *Xiao Tang Gu* – 小堂鼓
 - f) *Ban Gu* – 板鼓
 - g) Tambourine
 - h) Woodblock
